FOR ROACHES OR SILVERFISH:

- 1. Remove EVERYTHING from all kitchen and bathroom cabinets, drawers, and counters. Do not forger the medicine cabinet, toothbrushes, can openers, toasters, etc.
- 2. If you prefer, items may be left in the drawers and the drawers removed entirely from the cabinets with contents intact. Dresser drawers should be removed and placed on the bed.
- 3. Place all kitchen items on a table or floor, OUT OF THE KITCHEN and cover with a sheet. Any washing of cabinets should be done BEFORE SPRAYING! ONLY THE COUNTER TOPS, STOVE TOPS, AND BREAD BOARDS CAN BE WASHED AFTER SPRAYING.
- 4. Remove all loose paper. Adhesive shelf paper may be left in place.
- 5. Remove all items from linen closets, hall closets, etc. and place in center of the room.
- 6. Remove all items from bedroom closet floors and shelves. Clothing on hangers may be left in place if you simply pull it to the center of the rack and cover with a sheet of plastic. We recommend simply lifting the clothing off the rack and laying it on the bed.
- 7. Move all furniture 2-3 feet from the walls.
- 8. Remove all animals, birds, and fish. If you fish tank is too heavy to move outside, then place wet towels the top of the tank and disconnect the air pump in plastic. (You are cautioned to check with your fish dealer on any breeds that might suffer from a 6-hour lack of aeration, such breeds must be removed from the premises). NOTE: Do not disconnect the HEAT PUMPS! ONLY AIR PUMPS!
- 9. Windows may be left open (unless otherwise advised).
- 10. We will lock all doors when leaving, so make sure you have your keys.
- 11. Leave your home for 4 hours. If odor is offensive, ventilate thoroughly and leave for an additional 2 hours.
- 12. When you come home, be sure that chemical is COMPLETELY DRY before returning your items to the cabinets and closets. DO NOT WASH THE CABINETS, as this will destroy the effectiveness of the chemical. DO NOT be alarmed if you see insects after spraying. These will decrease as the chemical takes effect. Conditions should be "all clear" in 14-21 days.

FOR WATERBUGS, ANTS, CRICKETS, AND EARWIGS:

- Follow # 1,2,3,4 above but only from the COUNTER LEVEL DOWN.
- Follow #6 above but only for the closet floors.
- Follow #9,10,11,12. ALWAYS FOLLOW #8

FOR FLEAS AND TICKS:

- **Simply remove everything** from all floors and carpets (toy, shoes, pillows, magazines, racks, plants, stereo speakers, etc.), except your furniture. Vacuum extra heavily before service, then remove and dispose vacuum bag in trash facility. Closet floor should be empty. Stay out for 6 hours after service.
- All cats and dogs MUST be taken to the groomer or veterinarian to get a flea dipping. This
 treatment MUST be done on the SAME DAY SERVICE! WE cannot guarantee the treatment
 unless this is done!
- Follow #9,10,11,12. ALWAYS FOLLOW #8

FOR FABRIC PESTS:

• Follow #7,9,10,11,12. ALWAYS FOLLOW #8

FOR PEST IN STORED FOOD PRODUCTS:

- Simply remove all infested cereal grain products, silk flowers, wicker products, etc. Wrap all infected products in plastic and throw away in a trash facility.
- Follow # 1,2,3,4 and #9,10,11,12. ALWAYS FOLLOW #8
